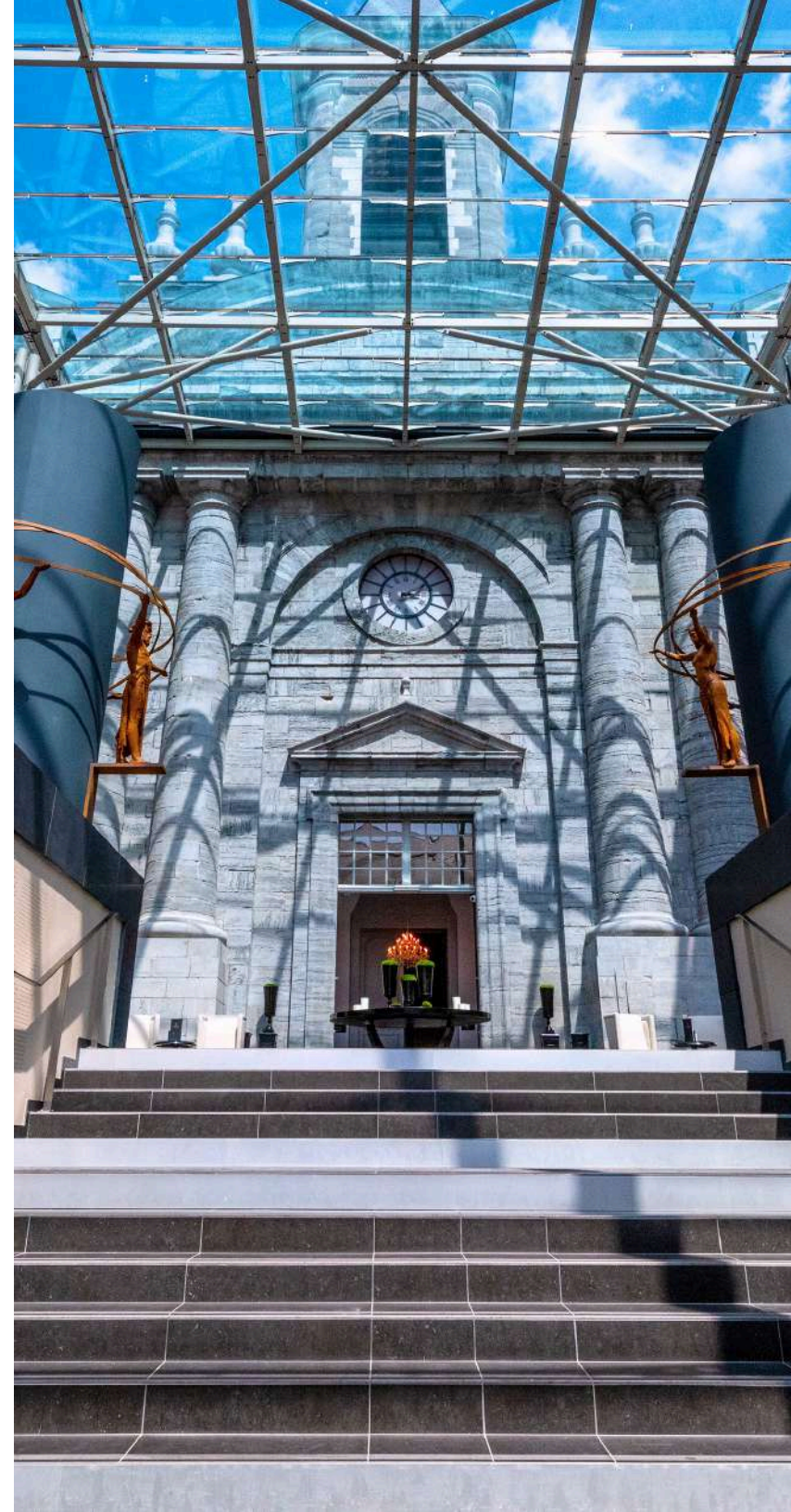
Experiences at the Royal Hainaut are the perfect symbiosis of work, relaxation, and a unique atmosphere.

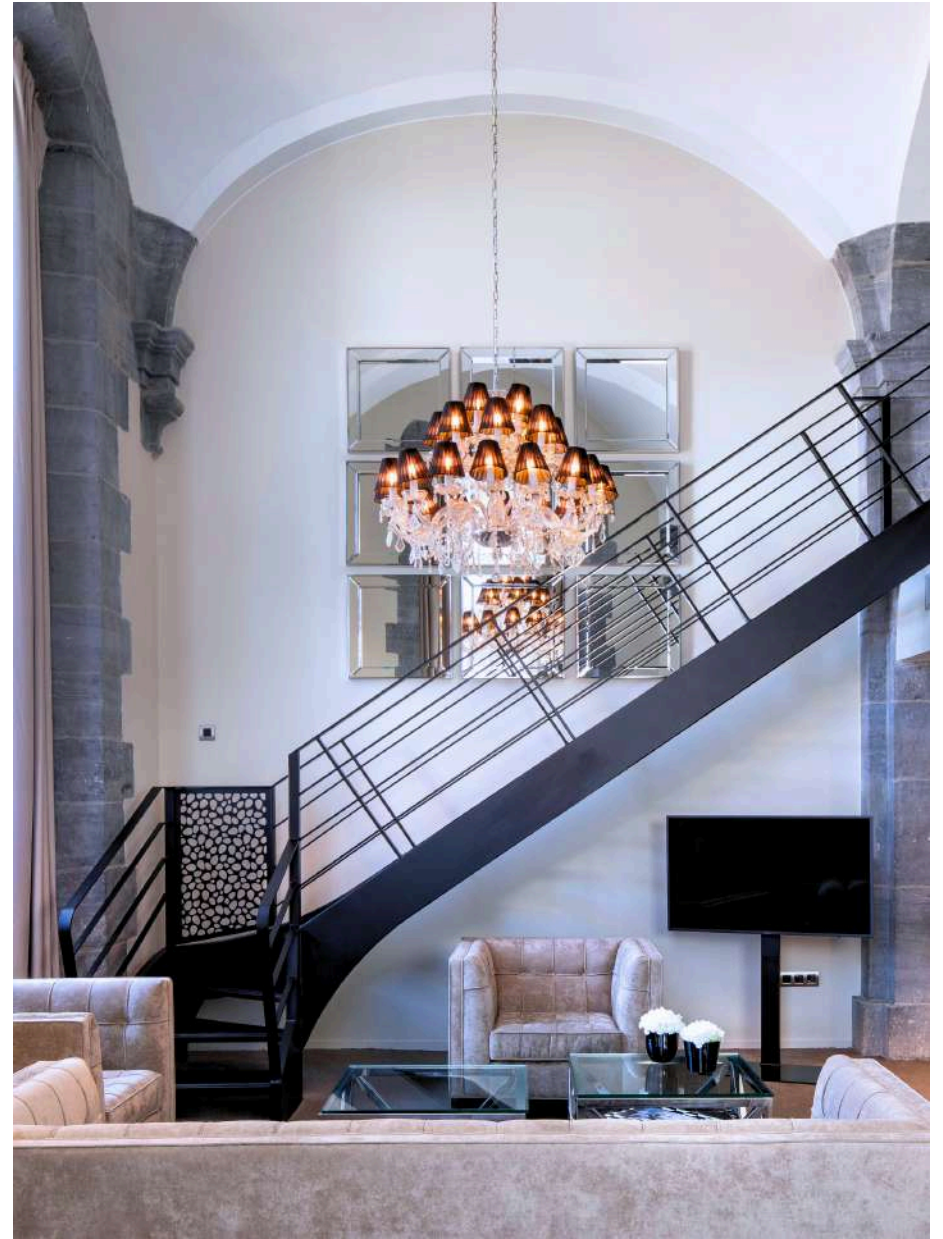


THE CHAPEL

It features a living room, a dining room, two bedrooms, a shower room, and a bathroom. It offers a stunning view of the Atrium and the Cour d'Honneur.

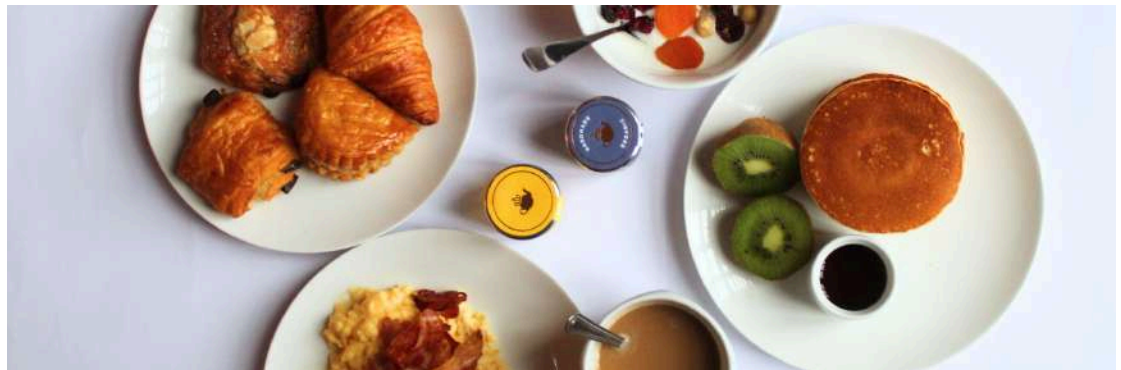


GASTRONOMY

SOME ADDRESSES FOR YOUR LEISURE OUTINGS...

Mérignies Golf: Established in 2008, the Golf de Mérignies is nicknamed "the most hilly golf course in the flat country." It covers a total of 185 hectares of nature near Valenciennes. With its 3 nine-hole courses, the golf course offers harmony and technicality accessible to both experienced players and beginners.

Hot Air Balloon Ride: Soar over the Valenciennes region aboard a hot air balloon. It's a unique way to discover the city and the Scarpe-Escaut regional nature park.

Arenberg Mining Site: A journey back in time to understand the history of a region that shaped France's industrial past. Discover the landscapes shaped by man since the 19th century and impressive industrial sites. Immerse yourself in the world of the "gueules noires."

Mormal Golf: Takes you through a hilly landscape of hedgerows, orchards, and bodies of water near the forest. At 6,022 meters long and par 72, the course is accessible to players of all levels.

L'Étang du Vignoble: Engage in outdoor activities, particularly at the water sports center, and enjoy the abundant nature just steps from the city center.

Matisse Museum: Founded by the painter Henri Matisse himself, the museum currently displays works by masters such as Picasso, Chagall, and Giacometti, enriching its collections over the years.

Scavenger Hunt in Valenciennes: Discover the charms, points of interest, and architecture of Valenciennes through an eight-stop journey starting from the Royal Hainaut.
